In his book I Surrender, Patrick Morley writes that the church's integrity problem is in the misconception "that we can add Christ to our lives, but not subtract sin. It is a change in belief without a change in behavior." He goes on to say, "It is revival without reformation, without repentance."

Al Johnson from Kansas gave his life to Jesus Christ. What made his story newsworthy was not his conversion, but that as a result of his newfound faith in Christ, he confessed to a bank robbery he had participated in when he was nineteen years old. Because the statute of limitations on the case had run out, Johnson could not be prosecuted for the offense. Still, he believed his relationship with Christ demanded a confession. And he voluntarily repaid his share of the stolen money!

There is a freedom from sin and guilt that is only found on the other side of repentance. This weekend's message addresses that necessary change in heart and behavior.
